## Advanced Archer Information

Alpine Academy is pleased to offer Dual College Credit Courses through Truckee Meadows Community College (TMCC). There are multiple options available for students who are focused on their future:

- Degree-seeking students will have the opportunity to focus on college classes as they work toward an associate degree.
- Career-focused students will have the opportunity to focus on the applied sciences courses as they work toward a technical degree or certification.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

All applicants must have the following:

- A minimum 90% percent attendance rate
- Submit an Application for the Advanced Archer Program
- Letter of recommendation from one core subject teacher (English, Math, Science, or History)
- No behavioral infractions for at least one semester (students who have infractions may still be ineligible after one semester, at the discretion of administration).
- Administrative Approval

**Freshmen** – Freshman may be identified by staff who show academic potential and responsibility in classes. Students may be approved for TMCC college credit classes by administration. Students must complete a weekly grade check.

**Sophomores and Juniors** – Must have a minimum GPA of a 3.0 and complete a weekly grade check.

**Seniors** – Must have a minimum GPA of a 2.5

Students who wish to participate in TMCC courses on the college campus must:

- Be Juniors and Seniors
- Provide their own transportation
- Take all State and school mandated tests, End of Course Exams, ACT, and any other tests as outlined by the school
- Attend mandatory Advanced Archer Seminar on Fridays at Alpine Academy and/or report grades weekly to Alpine Academy
- Administrative approval

Any exception to the above criteria is within the sole exclusive discretion of the Alpine Academy administration.

Any student who fails to meet the minimum requirements must wait at least one semester, prior to reapplying.

# Advanced Archer Application

- Letter of recommendation from one core subject teacher
- Letter of Intent: Write a 1-2 page letter about 1 of the following topics:
  - Why do you feel that you would be a good candidate for the Advanced Archer Program?
  - What lesson have you recently learned about and how has it changed your perspective on the topic? Apply this to the Dual Credit program.
  - What do you do in your extracurricular life that demonstrates a commitment to learning beyond the classroom?
  - Describe a life goal, and discuss the obstacles or difficulties that must be overcome if this goal is to be achieved.

		Student/Guardian will pay for the full cost of the course, fees, etc., in the event the student withdraws (after the refundable withdrawal date) or fails the course.
		Student/Guardian will be responsible for purchasing the textbooks and any additional fees or supplementary items required for the course. See administration for assistance as needed.
		Student/Guardian understands and agrees to complete all course work as described by instructor/professor, and will provide a supportive learning environment to assist in the student's success.
		Student/Guardian acknowledges college courses may have content that is appropriate for a mature audience. Student/Guardian agrees to participate and complete all course work, regardless of content as set forth by college.
		Student/Guardian acknowledges it is their responsibility to pay for the one time application fee, distance ed fee if the course is offered in person and the tech support fee.
		Student/Guardian acknowledges it is their responsibility to meet the attendance requirements for Advanced Archer Seminar.
		Student/Guardian acknowledges it is their responsibility to pay for classes that do not count toward a degree or certification, are under the college level or if they are offered at the Alpine Campus.
